Cuvée Negru de Purcari 2019

Cabernet-Sauvignon, Saperavi, Rara Neagra - dry red wine

History: Purcari is the most popular winery among Moldovan wine producers, being a leader in the production of premium wines in Moldova. The estate is located in the Purcari wine region, south of the country.

The winery's heritage dates back to the 19th century when French settlers partnered with local monks to begin planting Bordeaux varieties here, alongside the indigenous grape varieties.

Over the years, Purcari has won more than 250 medals in international competitions such as "Decanter World Wine Awards", "International Wine & Spirits Competition", "Challenge International du Vin", "Effervescents du Monde" and many other international contests. Purcari is the most awarded winery in Central and Eastern Europe.

Viticulture: Reasoned wine culture with respect for the environment and the natural cycles of the terroir and the vine.

Vinification: 70% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 25% Saperavi, 5% Rara Neagră - indigenous Moldovan grape variety.

Aged 18 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting: Deep and noble purple color wine, with a complex and intense bouquet, with notes of blue plum, ripe blackberry, black cherry, blueberry, sour cherry, blackcurrant, touches of leather, raspberry, violets. Deep, velvety taste with ample notes of delicate tannins and a long, sensual finish. The blend has a very nice balance between fruit and wood. The woody notes slightly dominates over the variety of flavours, but still fusion together into a fruity-savory mix of aromas, to gain more grip on the finish, excellently mixing power and finesse.

Perfect with hot meat dishes like pork steaks, juicy cooked veal cutlets and other grilled dishes. Decant 30 minutes before serving at 18-20°C.
